ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE CHIEF VETERINARY OFFICER FOR PASSENGERS TRAVELLING FROM GREAT BRITAIN

According to the confirmation of cases of foot and mouth disease (FMD) in the territory of Great Britain, Chief Veterinary Officer of Poland appeals to the persons, who had contact with the susceptible animals (cattle, sheep, goats, pigs and other biungulates e.g. deer, llamas, camels, antelopes, etc.) during their stay in Great Britain, especially in the Surrey County - that is persons, who have stayed or worked in holdings where abovementioned animals are kept or persons who were in contact with those animals in the other circumstances, to, before they will be in contact with the animals mentioned above in the territory of Poland:

- apply restricted hygiene rules, inter alia to change their clothes.
 Clothes, which have been used before during the contact with animals, should be cleaned and disinfected if it possible;
- clean and disinfect footwear, if it has been used before during the contact with the susceptible animals;
- use clothes different from those used during the contact with susceptible animals in the territory of Great Britain.
